64 BOA members in 1984; 74 MGs; 4TCs;13TDs;7As;32Bs;4BGTs;1C, & 10 Midgets. Of the 32Bs, 17 were Chrome bumpers.

Jim Pelletteire and Paul Garland were made "Lifetime BOA" members - 1984 Club Officially Incorporated in 1985.

110 BOA members in 1997; 95 MGs; 9Ts; 16As; 54Bs; 13 Midgets & 3 Magnettes.
